#### CBE Summer School Registration Information

Students may register for a **maximum of one course** for summer school with CBE. Students must choose between online or in-person. To view course offerings, delivery methods and locations for in person courses, please visit - <https://cbe.ab.ca/programs/high-school/summer-school/Pages/default.aspx> **BEFORE** completing the online course registration form.

**NOTE:** Course and location availability are extremely limited.

- **Registration and Summer School Timeline**
  - Students may **only take 1** course/program within the CBE. This includes - in person, online, Unique pathways dual credit, CTS
  - Students must complete this online course registration form by the deadline of **April 30 by 3:59pm**.

  - Submission of the form does not guarantee placement
  - If students are requesting CALM, a **mandatory consent form will be due by May 1** to Student Services. Access the form here: [Parental Notification and Opt-in Consent For CALM](#)
  - In early May, school counsellors submit course requests based on form submission date and course availability.
  - Notification of approved registration will be sent to families June 1 and 2. Please contact CBe-Learn or Chinook Learning directly if you have not received a notification by the end of June 2.

  - Please contact your school counsellor if you decide to withdraw from summer school, prior to June 26.
  - July 2: Summer School begins
  - July 14: Withdrawal and refund deadline – Withdrawal requests directly to summer school teacher
  - Diploma Exams: August 4-12, 2026
    - Only Social Studies 30-2 Part A and Part B Diploma Exams will be written at Chinook Downtown High School. All other Diploma Exams for in-person and online classes will be written at Nelson Mandela High School.
    - If you withdraw from the summer course but still want to write the diploma, you must contact Chinook Learning otherwise you will be unregistered
- \*\* **Please Note: If EAL students are registering for core courses, it has been strongly encouraged that only those at a LP 4 level apply for online courses.**
- EAL Course offerings -
  - English for Academic Success 15/25/35 for LP3 or higher (in-person)
  - Learning Strategies 15-25-35 for LP1 & LP2 (in-person)
